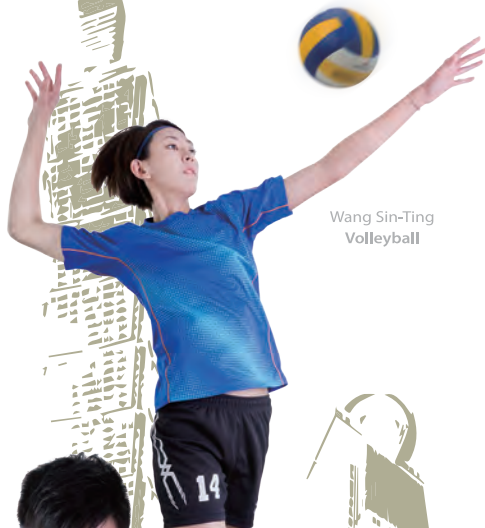

1. Pulled Turkey with Rice

Chiayi pulled turkey with rice is especially well-known in Taiwan. It is made with turkey meat pulled into shreds and layered over rice and then covered with braised minced pork and turkey gravy flavored with crystal sugar. The dish is enjoyed with pickled radish.

2. Rice Noodle Soup

This dish is made with simmered bone broth and chewy rice noodles. A little bit of finely chopped celery is sprinkled on top, and it is ready to be served. It also goes well with dishes like fried oily tofu and traditional side dishes.

3. Tianbula

Also known as Tempura or Oden, fish balls, fish rolls, fried oily tofu, pork blood cake, and daikon radishes are placed in soup base to cook. Special sauce is then poured onto the ingredients. After you've finished eating the dish, pour yourself a bowl of hot soup infused with the dish's rich flavor.

4. Rice Dumplings

This snack can be divided into two

varieties: Northern style Taiwanese oily rice dumplings and Southern style water-boiled rice dumplings. The first is chewy, and the second has a fragrant essence of glutinous rice.

5. Ice Desserts

Various types of fresh fruit is selected and placed on shaved ice, and then sugar water or condensed milk is poured over the top. The result is cool and refreshing. Shaved ice with assorted fruit or mango is the most popular.

6. Pig Blood Cake

This is a rectangular, rice cake made by steaming a mixture of pig blood and glutinous rice. Then it is dipped in thick soy sauce and coated with a thick layer of peanut powder and a sprinkle of parsley. The flavor is one-of-a-kind.

7. Stinky Tofu

Stinky tofu is made by deep-frying fermented tofu at a high temperature until golden and crispy with a soft inside. After the tofu is diced, soy sauce, garlic puree, and Taiwanese kimchi are added

on top. It is a representational snack that is loved throughout Taiwan.

8. Glutinous Rice Sausage

Glutinous rice is stir-fried with shallots, dried shrimp, and ground meat. Softened peanuts are then added and the mixture is steamed until fully cooked and ready to eat.

9. Hujiao Bing (Pepper Meat Pie)

Stuffed with pork and scallions seasoned with pepper, the pie is baked to a golden crisp in a charcoal oven. Take a bite and let the fragrant juiciness ooze out.

10. Tube Rice Pudding

Braised minced pork sauce are poured over glutinous rice and then topped with a layer of dried fish floss and slices of pickled radish or cucumber. The taste is delicious and texture is firm.

11. Braised Minced Pork with Rice

Stir-fried shallots and ground pork are braised and then poured over a bowl of rice. Delicious braised minced pork with rice is traditional Taiwanese culinary culture in a nutshell.

12. Bawan (Taiwanese Meatball)

Bawan is made with a mixture of stir-fried lean pork, shredded bamboo shoots, mushrooms, and dried shrimp, all wrapped in a skin made from tapioca flour. It is steamed until fully cooked (some will deep fry bawan after it is steamed) and then glazed with special sauce.

13. Oyster Vermicelli

Starch is used to thicken soup. Cooked vermicelli, chitterlings, and oysters are then added. After it is spiced up with condiments such as black vinegar,

soy sauce, and finely chopped garlic, this dish forms a delicious treat.

14. Beef Noodle Soup

There are two kinds of beef noodle soup in Taiwan: clear consommé and soy sauce braised. The most popular flavor is Sichuan braised beef noodle soup, made with select local beef that is cooked until firm. Other flavors, such as tomato, hot and spicy, shacha, and curry, have also been created.

15. Douhua (Tofu Pudding)

The texture of douhua is somewhere between tofu and soy milk. Sugar water, ginger juice, and soft, cooked peanuts are added to make the most traditional douhua. You can also eat this dish with mung beans, tapioca balls, adzuki beans, taro balls, and other ingredients.

16. Aiyu Jelly

The crystal clear aiyu jelly is made by rubbing aiyu seeds, it is a unique and refreshing summer dessert in Taiwan.

17. Fried Chicken

This is a general term for the fried

food in Taiwan, which mainly consists of popcorn chicken, pig blood cake, glutinous rice sausage, tempura, squid, and sweet potato fries. Ingredients are deep-fried along with basil and seasoned with salt and pepper.

18. Danzai Noodles

Originating in Tainan, this dish is made by placing noodles in shrimp broth, and then pouring specially made braised minced pork sauce on top. A marinated egg and shrimp are added to complete the classic danzai noodles.

19. Oyster Omelet

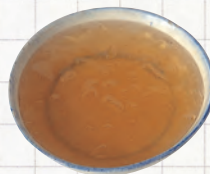
Fat, juicy fresh oysters are cooked into an omelet with eggs, bok choy or fried vegetables, tapioca starch, and sweet and spicy sauce is added before it is served.

20. Bubble Tea

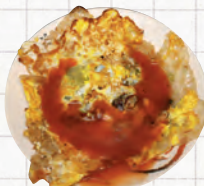
Originating in Taichung, bubble tea is the representative of the tea culture in Taiwan. The rich and creamy milk tea is paired with firm and chewy tapioca balls. The charm of this unique and aromatic drink is sweeping across the world.

Taiwan's official currency is the New Taiwan Dollar (TWD/NT\$). Notes are issued in values of NT\$2,000, NT\$1,000, NT\$500, and NT\$100, and coins come in denominations of NT\$50, NT\$10, NT\$5, and NT\$1.

TRA Train

Taiwan's cities are linked by an island-wide railway network. Train service is tiered into four main types ranging from ordinary (commuter) trains to various levels of express train. Tickets can be booked by phone or online before departure. Advance booking is strongly recommended if one is travelling on weekends or holidays.

Taxi

Convenient taxi service is available in most cities in Taiwan. Starting meter and mileage fares vary by county and city, but the difference is fairly small. In some cities, and for long-distance trips, cabbies may not use the meter, so it's a good idea to confirm the fare before embarking.



Visas

Foreign travelers may obtain tourist visas if they hold foreign passports or travel documents valid for more than six months in the Republic of China for purposes of sightseeing, business, family visits, study or training, medical treatments, or other legitimate activities. With the purpose of sightseeing, the staying period of tourist visas cannot exceed 180 days. Types of tourist visas include 14-day visa, 30-day visa, 60-day visa, 90-day visa, etc. 30-day visa-free privileges are afforded to citizens of 31 countries and 30-day landing visas are afforded to citizens of 3 countries. Travelers from Thailand, India, the Philippines, Vietnam and Indonesia who hold valid visas(including permanent residence permit) issued by US, EU and other 5 countries can apply for 30-day visa-free privilege and stay for 30 days in Taiwan for sightseeing purpose.

Project for Simplifying Visa Regulations for High-end Group Tourists from Southeast Asian Countries

Tourist groups organized by the designated travel agencies and corporate incentive groups from Southeast Asian countries, including India, Indonesia, Thailand, the Philippines and Vietnam, are qualified to apply for an entry visa to the R.O.C (Taiwan) with no need for proof of occupation and supporting financial documents.

Where to send application form?

For tourist groups from Thailand, Indonesia, Vietnam, and the Philippines, please send the form to our Kuala Lumpur office, Taiwan Tourism Bureau (Taiwan Visitors Association).

For tourist groups from India, please send the application form to our Singapore office, Taiwan Tourism Bureau (Taiwan Visitors Association)

Application processing time for large corporate incentive groups

- For groups of 80 or fewer people | Please apply at least 14 work days before arrival.
- 81-160 people | At least 16 work days in advance
- 161-200 people | At least 18 work days in advance

- 201-250 people | At least 20 work days in advance
- 251-400 people | At least 22 work days in advance
- More than 400 people | The application will be treated as a special case people

If the designated travel agency receives approval from the Taiwan Tourism Bureau, it has to send the tourists' passports, photos and visa application form to the R.O.C.'s overseas office in Southeast Asian countries at least 7 days before the tourist group's arrival.

Shopping and VAT Refunds

Foreign visitors who make purchases amounting to at least NT\$3,000 on the same day from the same Tax Refund Shopping (TRS)-posted store are eligible for a refund of the VAT paid on such purchases.

To claim the refund, you need to apply at your port of departure from the R.O.C. within 30 days of the purchase date. All qualifying items also must be

taken out of the country. When shopping, remember to ask the store to print your passport number on the Uniform Invoice (if

you forget, you can ask the store later to add this). You should also

ask the store for an Application Form

for Claiming VAT Refund and

apply for the refund at the

“Foreign Passenger VAT

Refund Service Counter” at the airport or seaport of departure.

Shopping Information

1. Sales tax is included in the price of purchases in Taiwan. Most shops issue a Uniform Invoice (receipt) as proof of purchase. Remember to keep your receipts in case you need to return or



exchange purchases.

2. All products and services in Taiwan are priced in New Taiwan dollars (NT\$). When shopping, make sure to carefully inspect your items to confirm the quality, quantity, origin, and price.
3. Businesses in Taiwan follow a fixed price (no haggling) system. Taipei Pass is a “touch-and-go” IC ticket for transport in Taipei. During the period of its validity, visitors can use it for unlimited rides on Taipei Metro and on Taipei City and New Taipei City buses. There are different types of Taipei Pass, including 1-day pass (NT\$180), 1-day pass (Gondola version, NT\$250), 2-day pass (NT\$310), 3-day pass (NT\$440), and 5-day pass (NT\$700). The 1-day pass (Gondola version) allows for unlimited rides on Taipei Metro, associated bus services, and Maokong Gondola.

TR PASS

The TR-PASS, announced by the Taiwan Railway Administration (TRA), targets

especially foreign youth students who come to Taiwan for a short-term visit and hold foreign passport and student ID (or Youth Travel Card issued by the Youth Development Administration, Minister of Education). Foreign youth students who hold a long-term residence permit are not allowed to purchase TR-PASS. As TR-PASS is for personal use only, students using TR-PASS should produce their foreign passports and student ID / Youth Travel Card to TRA’s ticket officers. Ticket types of TR-PASS include 5-day pass (NT\$599), 7-day pass (NT\$799), and 10-day pass(NT\$1,098); the 10-day pass is provided for foreign students only.

THSR Pass

The Taiwan High Speed Rail Corporation announces a THSR Pass which is valid for foreign visitors holding a tourist visa with 6-month validity, and can be purchased at THSR overseas distribution points only. Passengers had to present their passport when exchanging voucher, reserving seat, and boarding trains.

Pass types and prices:

3-day pass (NT\$2,400) Entitled to ride on THSR trains an unlimited number of times for 3 days.

Flexible 3-day pass (NT\$3,200) Entitled to ride on THSR trains an unlimited number of times for any 3 days within the specified week.

5-day standard joint pass (NT\$2,800) Entitled to ride Taiwan Railways trains Chu-Kuang class (inclusive) or lower an unlimited number of times. No reserved seat is available

when riding in Taiwan Railways Chu-Kuang class and Fu-Hsing class; and entitled to ride on THSR trains for any two days.

5-day express joint pass (NT\$3,600)

Entitled to ride Taiwan Railways trains Tzu-Chiang class (inclusive) or lower an unlimited number of times; and entitled to ride on THSR trains for any two days.

Taroko Gorge

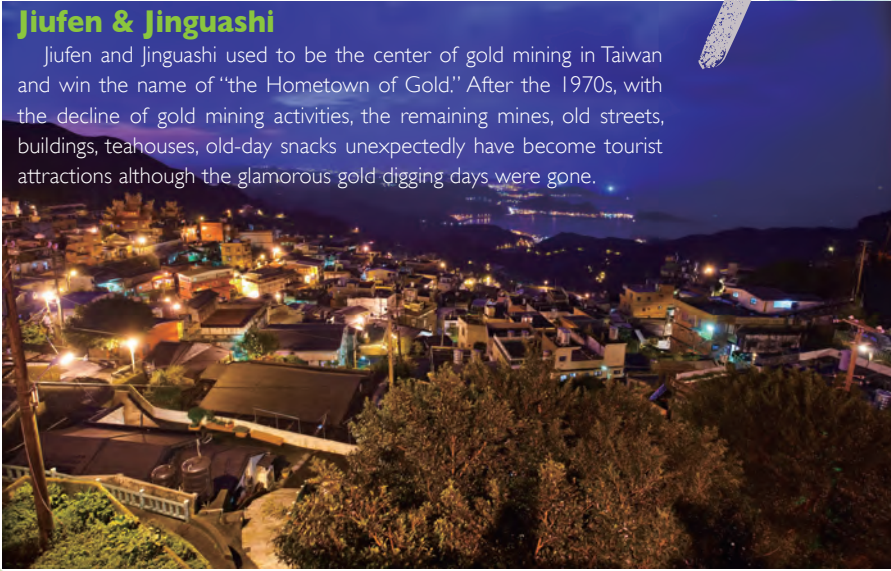

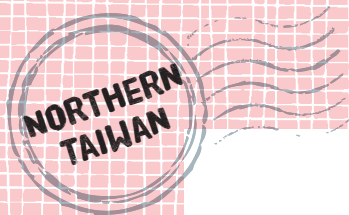
Hsinchu County

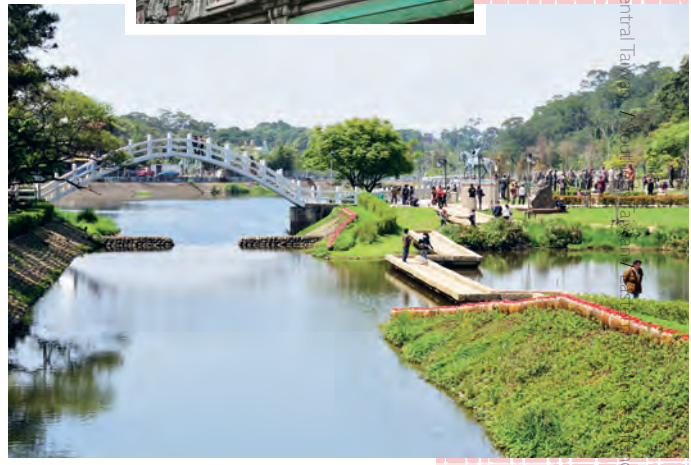
New Taipei City

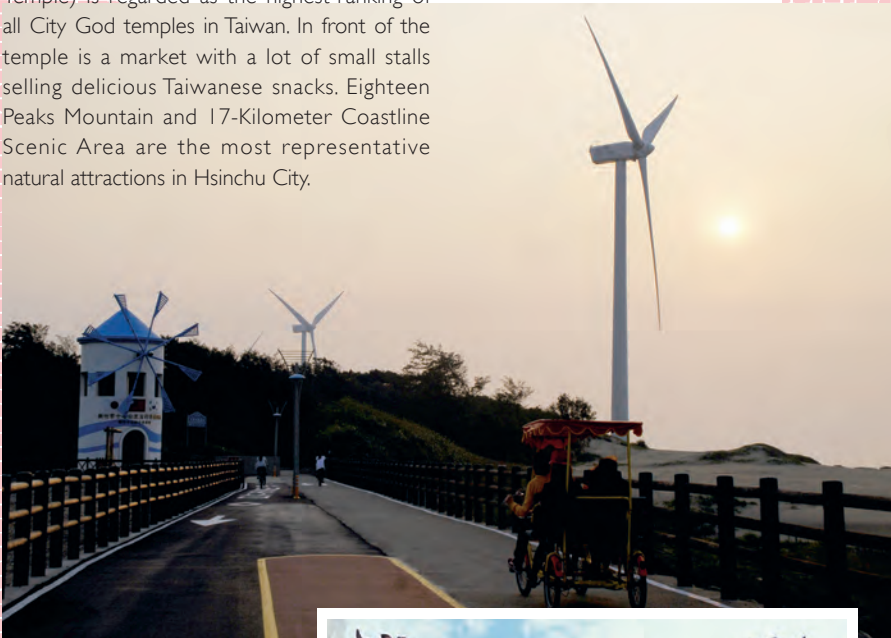


Hsinchu County

Apart from that, there are many Hakka communities in Hsinchu County, such as Neiwan Township and Xinpu Township, which preserved Hakka people's traditional culture and customs well. Even celebrities such as Peter Platt Chang and Wu Zhouliu have their former residences in Hsinchu.

Hsinchu City

Although Hsinchu City has been renowned for its Science-based Industrial Park, historic sites such as Hsinchu City God Temple, Hsinchu Municipal Government Hall, and Yin His East Gate have also been reserved through hundreds of year. Established in Qing Dynasty, Hsinchu City God Temple (Chenghuang Temple) is regarded as the highest-ranking of all City God temples in Taiwan. Window on China Theme Park

Window on China Theme Park is the first theme park in Asia, featuring majestic displays of world famous architecture miniatures. It is also the first family theme park lead in Taiwan. In recent years, besides making efforts on the entertainment, Window on China Theme Park has reached the achievement of being the environmental education field. Therefore, visitors do not only enjoy fun at the Theme Park, but also acquire the knowledge during the hours. The Global Voyager Mini

Train connects two major parts of the Theme Park. Based upon the characteristics of the service, there are four topics at Window on China Theme Park including Mini World, Amusement Park, Water Park, and the Playhouse.

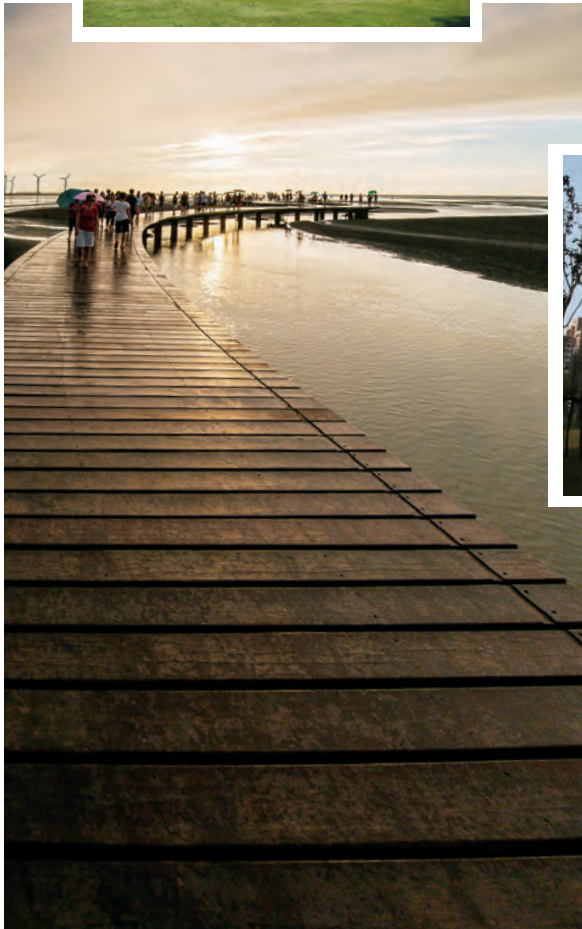




Miaoli County

Apart from that, major tourism areas in Miaoli include the Sanyi Wood Sculpture and Old Mountain Line Tourism Area, Dahu Strawberry Culture Park, Gongguan's agricultural products, fruits from Zhuolan and Sanwan, Tai'an Hot Spring Scenic Area, Mingde Reservoir Scenic Area, and Nanzhuang Lion's Head Mountain Scenic Area.





Taichung City

Among the many sites of interest in the city are the historic Lecheng Temple, the ornate and much-visited Chenghuang Temple, the three-hall style Wanhe Temple, the 3-grade-three national historic Chang Liao Family Shrine, as well as the 200-plus-yearold Zhenlan Temple in Dajia further add to Taichung's yesteryear charms. These includes Changhua's landmark Baguashan Great Buddha; Longshan Temple, a national historic site known as "Taiwan's Forbidden City"; and Tianhou Temple, a county historic site dedicated to Meizhou's Mazu.



Yunlin County

Yunlin generates more revenue from agriculture than any other county. Seasonal harvest schedule includes rice and soy bean sauce from Xiluo; pomelos from Douliu; peanuts from Beigang; coffee from Gukeng, and more from farmsthroughout the county. Yunlin'ssimilarly advanced aquaculture industry raises significant quantities of grouper, milkfish, mullet roe, geloina (horseshoe) clam, and tilapia. In addition, Yunlin also has the highest concentration oftemples on the island; among all, the 290-year-old Beigang Chaotian Temple, built in the Qing Dynasty, has been the most renowned one.

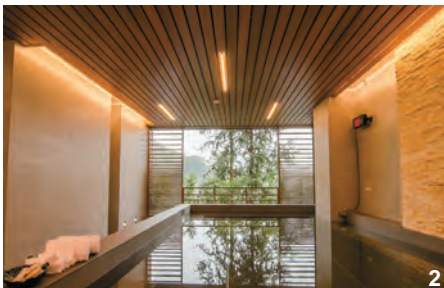

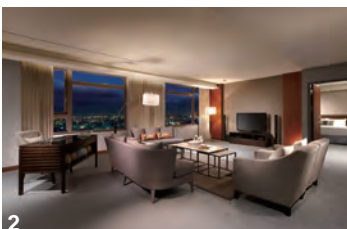

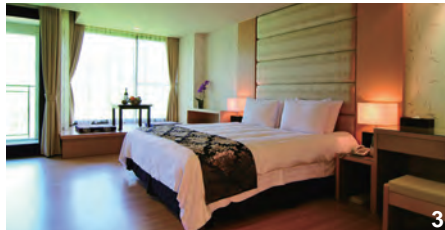

Chiayi City

Chiayi City is situated on the north end of Chianan Plain, bordered by Chiayi County. At 23.5o north latitude, the Tropic of Cancer passes just 1km south of Chiayi City. The city has been the county seat from the earliest days and thus an origin of culture and the arts, including koji pottery, one of the most precious traditional craft skills in Taiwan.

Chiayi County

Blessed by both mountain and coastal scenery, the county is home to the Alishan, Southwest Coast, and Siraya National Scenic Areas and the only one county in Taiwan to have three national scenic areas.

Tainan City

Tainan is the birthplace of Taiwan and the oldest city on the island. In 1661, the Ming loyalist Cheng Cheng-kung drove the Dutch from Taiwan and established his administration in Tainan. Tainan remained the political, economic and cultural center of Taiwan up to the late nineteenth century. As a result, Tainan is home to many famous historic sites.

Kaohsiung City

A thriving international metropolis at the southern tip of Taiwan, Kaohsiung was the host city for the 2009 World Games. Due to the regulating effects of the marine climate, Kaohsiung is generally sunny and enjoys pleasant weather year-round, and earns the name of "Taiwan's Maritime Capital."

Pingtung County

Taiwan's southernmost county, Pingtung covers a long territory with a border defined by mountains to the north, the Pacific Ocean to the east, the Taiwan Strait to the west, and the Bashi Channel to the south. Due to its subtropical location, Pingtung enjoys springlike weather all year round. Graceful coconut trees add to the county's ample South Pacific charms. In addition, Pingtung is home to Kenting National Park, Taiwan's first National Park.

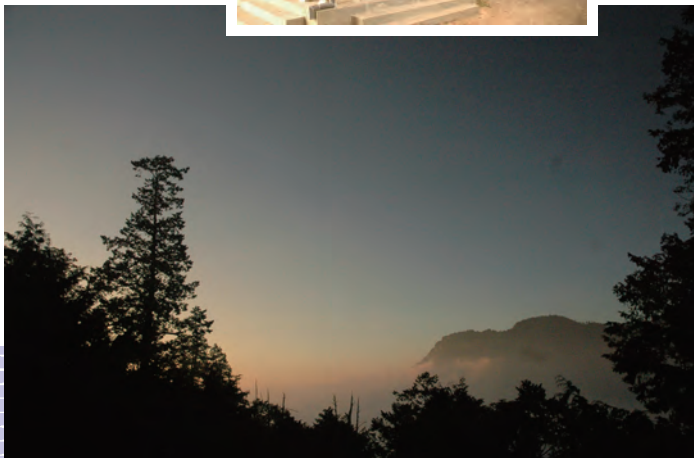
Chiayi City



As the starting point of Alishan Forest Railway, Chiayi City's attractions are mostly of historical interest. Foremost among these is Lantan (Holland Lake), called "red-hair pond" during the Dutch colonization period. "Chu-Lo" County, a large territory that incorporated much of modern-day Chiayi County, was created during the Qing Dynasty; the first stockade in Taiwan was built at the same time. Diversified local specialties, snacks, dessert pastries have been preserved to date, including square cookies, traditional Japanese confectionery, yokan, turkey rice, rice pudding, braised fish head casserole, etc.

Chiayi County

Alishan, located in the east part of the county by Taiwan's tallest peak, Yushan, is the homeland of the Tsou indigenous people. This area is famous for its breathtaking sunrise views and cloud formations, towering ancient trees, colorful cherry blossoms, the world-famous Alishan Forest Railway, and the Tsou aboriginal culture. The fishing harbors of Dongshi and Budai on the west coast are good places to experience the county's coastal ecology and views. The Aogu Wetland Forest Park, also in Dongshi, is the largest lowland forest park in Taiwan. And in the plains area, one can make an educational visit to the Tropic of Cancer Monument.





Tainan City



After the Qing pacification of Taiwan in 1683, the Taiwan Prefectural Capital was established in Tainan, the ancient capital of Taiwan. The city became a large metropolis due to a great amount of immigrants from China. Famous attractions include historic sites, such as Chikanlou, Anping Great Fort, and Eternal Golden Castle, and natural ecology spots, such as Qigu Lagoon, Qigu Salt Mountains, Jingzaijiao Tile-paved Salt Fields, Baihe Lotus, and Guanziling Mud Springs. Visitors can also sample a wide selection of traditional snacks and Dongshan's locally-grown Arabica coffee. Every year on the 15th day of the first lunar month, the spectacular Yanshui Beehive Rockets Festival attracts throngs of visitors to Tainan.

Kaohsiung City

Kaohsiung City is an ethnic melting pot, joining Hakka communities, the Pingpu, Tsou, Rukai, Bunun, and Paiwan indigenous tribes, and a military community culture. The city is also home to many popular attractions, including the Love River, Xiziwan Bay, Qijin, Lotus Pond, the Old City of Zuoying, Meinong's Hakka village, Neimen Songjiang Battle Array, Fo Guang Shan Buddhist monastery in Dashu, Maolin National Scenic Area, Shanping Forest Ecological Science Park, and Tianliao Moon World. Taiwan's biggest mall and well-known night markets complete the scene for a thoroughly satisfying trip.



Pingtung County



Pingtung is home to Kenting National Park. Other famous attractions here include the island Eden of Xiaoliuqiu, Dapeng Bay National Scenic Area, and Taiwan's best paragliding area, Saijia Air Park. Pingtung is also a wintering stop for migratory birds, including shrikes, and in

October, grayfaced buzzards, making this a good spot to enjoy the avian ecology. Apart from that, the county has a number of renowned local specialties, including Donggang for Bluefin tuna, Linbian Township's black pearl wax apple, the coffee of Dewen, onions of Checheng and Hengchun, and pig's feet of Wanluan.

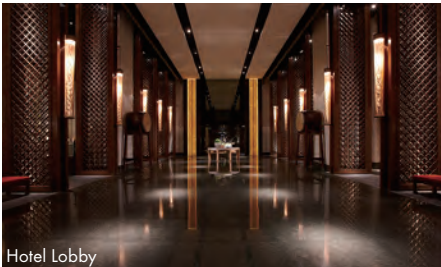

Yilan County

The city of Yilan is located in the central part of the Lanyang Plain. Streams and rivers provide a constant source of replenishment for the nutrients in the soil here, making Yilan a breadbasket county. The county is home to Asia's second longest highway tunnel, the Hsuehshan Tunnel, which has largely reduced the driving time between Yilan and Taipei.

Hualien County

Taiwan's biggest county, Hualien borders the Pacific Ocean to the east and is hemmed in by the Central Range to the west. With all of its natural beauty, most of Hualien is a national scenic area. Visitors to the county can enjoy the impressive gorges at Taroko National Park, the magnificence of Yushan National Park, the stunning natural landscapes of the East Coast National Scenic Area, and the rustic charms of the East Rift Valley National Scenic Area.

Taitung County

Taitung County borders the Xiuguluan River to the north, the Central Range to the west, and the Pacific Ocean to the east. Green Island and Orchid Island (Lanyu) are both a short distance offshore from Taichung. From coastal areas to mountain highs, Taitung greets visitors to a land of ecological richness and rustic beauty.

Penghu County

Composed of 90 islands, Penghu County is the only island county in Taiwan. Basalt columns sculpted by the elements are a dominant part of the geological landscape on the Penghu Islands. The clear waters of Penghu Bay and strong winter winds have put Penghu on the map as an international hot spot for competitive sailing.

Kinmen County

Situated just off the coast of Mainland China, Kinmen County is composed of 12 islands, including Kinmen Island, Lie Island (Little Kinmen), etc. Military administration of Kinmen was lifted in 1992, marking the start of the island's emergence as a tourism destination. In January 2001, direct cross-strait links were opened between Kinmen and Xiamen in mainland China, putting the island in a key position for cross-strait interactions.

Matsu County

Matsu offers visitors unforgettable travel memories, such as defensive fortifications built by the military, a sincere and kind-hearted people, a relaxed mountain village life, precious island ecosystems, traditional-style delicacy and wine.





Yilan County



From natural environments and cold and hot springs to a wealth of ocean recreation resources and verdant country scenes, Yilan offers the perfect setting to slow down and enjoy nature at its best. Surrounded by submarine hot springs that emit steam all year round, Guishan Island is a rare sight in the Pacific. The sea area here is a favorite haunt for whales and dolphins. For a relaxing hot spring soak, one can choose between the lowland hot springs of Jiaoxi Township and the carbonic acid cold springs in Su'ao Township, one of only two cold springs in Southeast Asia.



Hualien County

Besides the world-famous Taroko National Park, Hualien's popular attractions, such as East Coast National Scenic Area, Xiuguluan River, Qixing Lake (Qixingtian), and Liyu (Carp) Lake, are all great sites for enjoying ocean views and water activities. The rape flower fragrance from the fields of East Rift Valley, milk

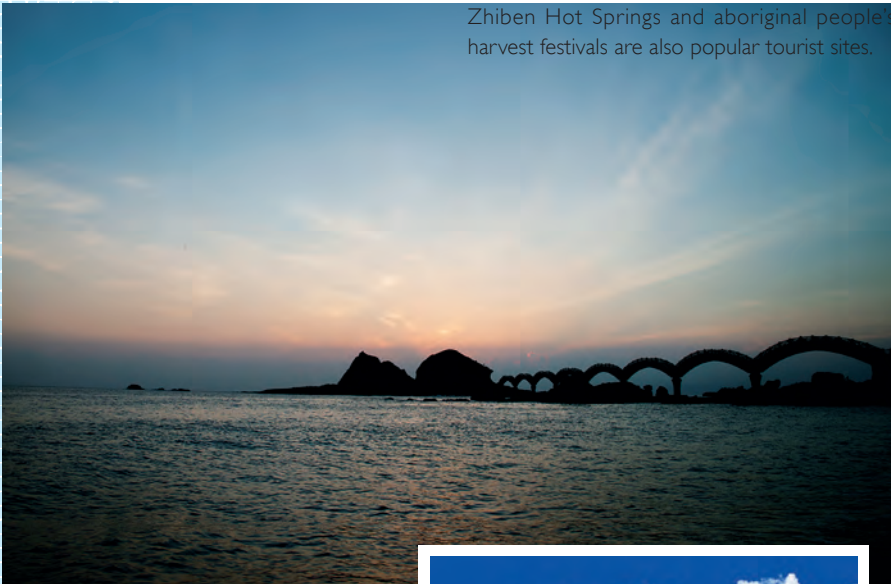
flavor from Chao Feng Ranch and Ruisui Farm, and tea leave aroma from tea plantations weave together into an idyllic picture. Sampling ice cream in the Hualien Sugar Factory (Guangfu Sugar Plant), and enjoying a soak in Antong, Hongye or Ruisui hot springs, are favorite ways to experience a relaxing leisure time.

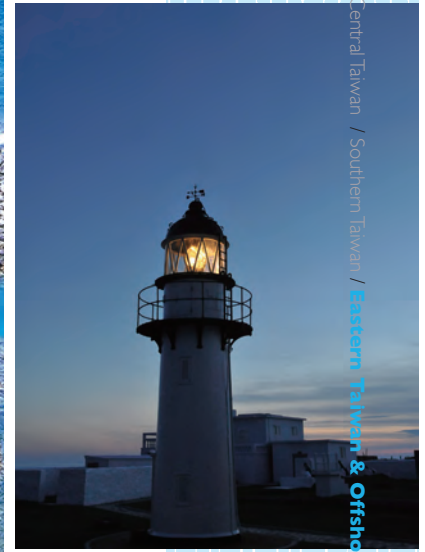


Taitung County



With a coastal line stretching up to 176 kilometers, Taitung County has a number of coastal attractions, such as Xiaoyeliu, Baxian Cave (Baxiandong), Stone Umbrella (Shiyusan), Sanxiantai (Terrace of the Three Immortals), and Chenggong, Fugang Fishing Harbors, in which one can sample the freshest seafood. Cyclists are also well-served in Taitung, Taiwan's oldest bikeway—the Guanshan Bicycle Trail—is located here, and other cycling routes can be enjoyed in Longtian Village (Luye Township) and Chishang Township, all while cyclists are surrounded by fairytale-like scenic beauty. Zhiben Hot Springs and aboriginal people's harvest festivals are also popular tourist sites.





Penghu County



Penghu is an excellent choice for seaside fun, with blue seas, clear skies, soft white beaches, plenty of beach and water recreation facilities, and an amazing marine ecology and scenic beauty. Well-known tourist spots include Penghu Great Bridge (Trans-Ocean Bridge), Penghu Tianhou Temple (designated as a national historic site), Xiyu Western Fort, Tongliang Great Banyan (more than 300 years old), Fongguei Cave, Whale Cave, Lintou Park, and the most romantic Twin Hearts Stone Weir.



Kinmen County

Kinmen County is home to several rare and protected bird species, sorghum spirits, southern Fujian-style cuisines, seafood, ancient Fujian-style houses, and western buildings. For nearly a half century, Kinmen was a battleground in Taiwan's defense against the mainland forces. However, the military installations developed at that time have today become an invaluable tourism resource for the islands.



Matsu County

Located northwest of Taiwan, the Matsu Islands consisted of 36 islets. Most of the Matsu Islands are mainly made of granite with the effects of millions of years of sea and wind erosion having formed a wide variety of terrain and scenery, such as precipitous cliff faces, ocean erosion caves, etc., can be seen all over the islands, especially Dongyin. 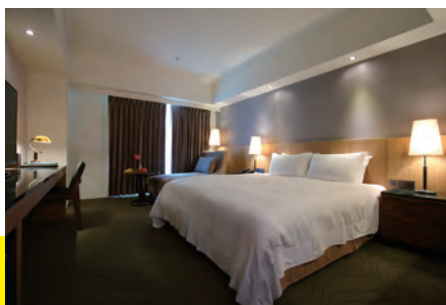

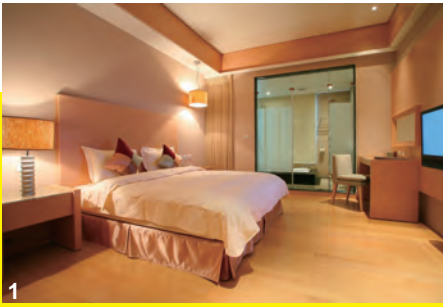
